#### **Types of Application**

- 1. Is there some new truth to put faith in?
- 2. Is there some specific stand of faith to take?
- 3. Is there an example to follow?
- 4. Is there an example to avoid?
- 5. Is there a sin to forsake?
- 6. Is there a command to obey?
- 7. Is there a promise to act upon?
- 8. Have I learned new truths about God, Jesus Christ or the Holy Spirit?
- 9. Is there some difficulty (difficult passage) to explore further?
- 10. Is there something requiring prayer?
- 11. Is there an action that needs to be done?
- 12. Is there an attitude that needs to be changed?
- 13. Is there a relationship that needs attention?
- 14. Is there a need for counsel?

## Written Steps of an Application

- 1. State the verse you are applying.
- 2. State what the verse is saying to you personally.
- 3. State what you feel your need is.
- 4. State what you are going to do.
- 5. State how you plan to check-up on yourself.

It is one thing to plan a course of action as a result of God's Word. It is another thing to actually follow through with the application. That is why a check-up plan is such a good idea. A check-up can take any number of shapes. It can be a note placed in a prominent place to remind you. Or it can be a trusted friend whom you ask for help and reminders.
