Pray that the leader would...

- 1. Realize his personal sinfulness and daily need of cleansing by the blood of Jesus.
- 2. Recognize his personal inadequacy and depend upon God for wisdom and knowledge and courage to do what he knows is right.
- Reject all counsel that violates spiritual principles and trust God to prove him right.
- 4. Resist those who would pressure him to violate his conscience.
- 5. Reverse, by God's power, the trend of socialism and humanism which edifies man rather than God.
- 6. Be ready to forsake personal ambition and political office for the sake of nation, if necessary.
- 7. Rely on prayer and the Word of God for the source of his strength and direction every day.
- 8. Practice dignity, honor, trustworthiness and righteousness.
- 9. Remember to be a good example in conduct to the fathers and sons of the nation.
- 10. Be reminded daily that he is accountable to God for his actions.
